Please note that the Tele Vue eyepieces for sale at NEAF have minor cosmetic metalwork or coating blemishes which have no effect on performance. However, they do not meet Tele Vue's high cosmetic standard for goods available through our dealer network. Each eyepiece has been marked to distinguish it as a "cosmetic".

Because quantities of Tele Vue eyepieces vary and are limited in number based on our inspection, all sales will be on a **first come – first served** basis. All Tele Vue items will be sold **AS IS; no returns, no deliveries, no dealers.** All prices include New York State and local sales tax. **CASH ONLY, please. No checks or credit cards.**

In the spirit of our relationship with fellow amateur astronomers, we ask you to honor our request that whatever you buy will be for **your own personal use** and **will not be offered for resale.** Due to limited quantities, we have instituted the following sales restrictions to allow the fairest chance for attendees to get the Tele Vue eyepieces they want, while still making it possible to purchase eyepieces for friends who couldn't attend NEAF:

- **Sales Policy:** Limit of up to a total of 2 Tele Vue 1 ¼" eyepieces of the same focal length per person; 2" eyepieces are limited to 1 per person per focal length
- **Sales Policy: (effective Saturday AFTER 2pm and all day Sunday):** the quantity limit will be lifted for those purchasing Tele Vue eyepieces for friends who could not attend the Forum. If we have sold out of the eyepiece you want, we apologize.
